Few cherished and nourished memories and most importantly experienced ones. I am extremely thankful to Somaiya Trust to recollect and share.

In schooldays, I was not the best in studies but better in "Liking subjects". To me liking subjects were those in which I got more than expectations. For example, I was expecting 75 out of 100 marks in Maths exam and I got 85. This is something more than the expectations and the same has happened in my life. I never dreamed of tomorrow. In school days, I never dreamed of becoming an engineer. While doing engineering, I never dreamed of becoming a professional and entrepreneur. Till date, I have structurally designed more than 450 buildings which include residential, commercial, industrial & institutional. To name a few are Temple for 'Swami Samartha Seva Mandal' at Dombivli, 'Infants Jesus Church' at Thakurli. The clients were MNC's like HUIL, KCLL, RIL, J & M, Govt & Semi Govt like MCGM, MSEDCL, ARCI, KDMC, MIDC, private builders and institutes. Subsequently, I got the registration of "Govt. Approved Valuer" after 10 years of my practice and started practising as panelled valuer of various banks. 'Structural Audit and rehabilitation' is another field which we have entered and as of now carried out audits of more than 200 buildings. Presently, I am on 'Expert Committee' of KDMC for dilapidated buildings.

Right from beginning of my practice, I am follower of good professional ethics and as a result I am always surrounded by so many like-minded people. I am keen rather fond of sharing knowledge, developing relations rather than earning money. This has given me satisfaction in my professional practice. In professional practice, it is not only important to guide your client but also to convince him to make him understand.

To name a few, I am structural engineer of 22 institutional buildings including my own school, above mentioned two monuments and few temples.
